OREGON TRAIL RECREATION DISTRICT FEE IN LIEU OF TAXES PERMANENT OVERRIDE

THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE LEVY WOULD BE USED IS AS FOLLOWS:

STARTING NEXT YEAR AND EACH AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER, LEVY FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF (\$550,000) SHALL BE USED FOR THE PURPOSES OF PAYING ALL LAWFUL OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE DISTRICT, INCREASING THE DISTRICT'S ABILITY TO ADD MORE PROGRAMS AND SERVE MORE PEOPLE, AND IMPROVING PHYSICAL FACILITIES OF THE DISTRICT. On November 7, 2023, an election will be held on the question of changing the way the Oregon Trail Recreation District is funded as provided for Resolution No. 23-01 of the Board of Directors of the Oregon Trail Recreation District adopted on the 11th day of September 2023. The levy will be assessed beginning the tax year of 2024 and continuing each and every year thereafter. It is estimated that Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$550,000.00) will be collected each year. This levy will replace the \$36 annual fee in lieu of a tax per household currently assessed by the District.

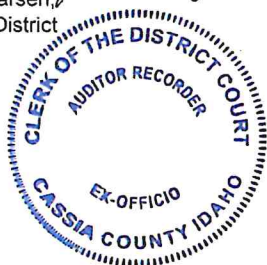

HOUSE BILL 340

What: [HB 340](#) amends several sections in [Chapter 4, Title 34, Idaho Code](#), to clarify and standardize the voter registration process. [§ 34-411](#) has been amended to require that all registration applicants:

1. Submit a completed [application](#),
2. Show [proof of identity](#), and
3. Show [proof of residence](#).

[§ 34-411\(3\) & \(4\)](#) include a [specific list](#) of acceptable forms of documentation an applicant can show to satisfy these last two requirements.

[Absent from this list](#) are [student ID cards](#). However, [§ 49-2444\(22\)](#) requires ITD to issue [free ID cards](#). Electors can use these free ID cards to both register to vote and to vote at the polls.

When: [July 1, 2023](#)

Impact: Election officials will want to be mindful that, [as of July 1, 2023](#):

- [Student ID cards cannot be used to register.](#)
- The requirement to show proof of both identity and residence applies regardless of how an applicant registers (online or in-person).
- [Only documents listed in § 34-411\(3\) to prove identity and § 34-411\(4\) to prove residence will be accepted.](#)
