Resolution No. 26-001

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE ROCK CREEK RURAL FIRE PROTECTION, TWIN FALLS COUNTY IN THE STATE OF IDAHO INITIATING PROCEEDINGS TO LEVY A TEMPORARY OVERRIDE LEVY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Rock Creek Rural Fire Protection District has deemed it essential and necessary to propose an increase in the property tax levy be obtained for the protection of public health, life, and property of its residents.

WHEREAS this proposition would authorize and empower the district to levy a tax override, as permitted by Idaho Code 63-802(3), in the amount of an additional One million three hundred thousand dollars (\$1,300,000) each year for two (2) years, to be used for the purpose of maintaining, and operating the district.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the question which shall be submitted by ballot to the qualified electors of the district for their ratification or rejection at an election on November 3, 2026, shall be as follows:

“Shall the Board of Commissioners of Rock Creek Rural Fire Protection District, Idaho be authorized and empowered to **temporarily** increase the property tax levy as permitted by Section 63-802(3) Idaho Code adding an additional One million three hundred thousand dollars (\$1,300,000) each year for two (2) years, provided by resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the Rock Creek Rural Fire Protection District adopted on August 13, 2026, to be voted on November 3, 2026.

The purpose of the levy is for maintaining and operating the district. The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer of the proposed **temporary** levy beginning tax year 2027 is a tax of seventy-eight dollars and thirty-two cents (\$78.32) per one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing levy that will expire tax year 2026 and that currently costs eighty-two dollars and thirty-two cents (\$82.32) per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. If the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is expected to decrease by four dollars (\$4.00) per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. Approval of this levy override is necessary to maintain the protection of its residents’ public health, life, and property.
