NOTICE OF ELECTION
MAY 17, 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to Resolution No. 2-22 adopted by the Burley City Council on March 1, 2022, an election will be held in the City of Burley on Tuesday, May 17, 2022, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. and 8:00 o'clock P.M. for the purpose of voting upon the question and proposition of increasing the levy on the taxable property within the City of Burley by the amount necessary to produce the sum of One Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$165,000.00) in excess of that otherwise allowed by law, for each of the tax years 2022 and 2023, to provide additional funding for the City of Burley Streets Department and the continued construction, repair, and maintenance of city streets and the costs of materials, equipment, and personnel related thereto as provided in Resolution 2-22 of the Burley City Council adopted on the 1st day of March, 2022. The question to be submitted to the electors of the City of Burley shall be by ballot reading substantially as follows: **OFFICIAL BRIEF STATEMENT:** The purpose for which the levy shall be used is the continued construction, repair, and maintenance of City of Burley streets and costs of equipment, materials, and personnel related thereto. The date of the election is May 17, 2022. The dollar amount estimated to be collected each year from the levy is \$165,000.00 for each of the tax years 2022 and 2023. The length of time in which the proposed levy will be assessed is two years. The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer of the proposed levy is a tax of \$21.57 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing levy that will expire on the last day of tax year 2021 and that currently costs \$21.57 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. If the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is not expected to change from the previous year.

SHALL THE LEVY UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF BURLEY BE INCREASED TO PRODUCE THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$165,000.00) IN EXCESS OF THAT OTHERWISE ALLOWED BY LAW, FOR EACH OF THE TAX YEARS 2022 AND 2023, TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE CITY OF BURLEY STREETS DEPARTMENT AND THE CONTINUED CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF CITY OF BURLEY STREETS AND COSTS OF EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, AND PERSONNEL RELATED THERETO AS PROVIDED IN RESOLUTION NO. 2-22 OF THE BURLEY CITY COUNCIL ADOPTED ON THE 1st DAY OF MARCH, 2022?
