THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE LEVY WOULD BE USED IS AS FOLLOWS:

STARTING NEXT YEAR AND EACH AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER, LEVY FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF (\$550,000) SHALL BE USED FOR THE PURPOSES OF PAYING ALL LAWFUL OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE DISTRICT, INCREASING THE DISTRICT'S ABILITY TO ADD MORE PROGRAMS AND SERVE MORE PEOPLE, AND IMPROVING PHYSICAL FACILITIES OF THE DISTRICT. THE ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST TO THE TAXPAYER OF THE PROPOSED LEVY, IN THE FORM OF A TAX, IS \$48 PER \$100,000 OF TAXABLE ASSESSED VALUE, PER YEAR, BASED ON CURRENT CONDITIONS. THE PROPOSED LEVY WILL REPLACE THE EXISTING FEE OF \$36 PER HOUSEHOLD PER YEAR.

SHALL THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE OREGON TRAIL RECREATION DISTRICT BE AUTHORIZED TO CHANGE FROM AN ANNUAL \$36 PER HOUSEHOLD FEE AND LEVY A PROPERTY TAX WITH A MAXIMUM RATE OF 0.048% OR \$48 PER \$100,000 OF TAXABLE ASSESSED VALUE, PER YEAR?

The Board of Directors of the Oregon Trail Recreation District has adopted the following Official Statement:

On November 7, 2023, an election will be held on the question of changing the way the Oregon Trail Recreation District is funded as provided for Resolution No. 23-01 of the Board of Directors of the Oregon Trail Recreation District adopted on the 11th day of September 2023. The levy will be assessed beginning the tax year of 2024 and continuing each and every year thereafter. It is estimated that Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$550,000.00) will be collected each year. This levy will replace the \$36 annual fee in lieu of a tax per household currently assessed by the District.

- IN FAVOR OF** changing from an annual \$36 per household fee to a property tax levy with a maximum rate of 0.048% or \$48 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year?
- AGAINST** changing from an annual \$36 per household fee to a property tax levy with a maximum rate of 0.048% or \$48 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year?
