JOB SUMMARY:

This is a full-time position, working non-traditional hours. The communications center is staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays. Under general supervision, the Communication Officer must be able perform a variety of duties involved in the receipt of emergency and non-emergency information and be able to dispatch law enforcement, fire, ambulance, and other emergency assistance.

MINIMUM JOB REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have a high school diploma or GED equivalent and be at least 18 years of age. Must have the ability to type at a proficient rate and accuracy on a computer keyboard. Must have mapreading skills and ability to distinguish and translate directional information i.e. north, south, east, west
- Duties require sufficient mobility to work in a typical office setting and use standard office equipment. Required to have vision to read printed materials and computer screens. Required to have hearing and speech to communicate in person or via telephone and radio.
