- b) General matters were reported. Items of note included:
 - i) Treasurer Greener reviewed the monthly reports for the Board. She provided reports that showed fiscal year to date interest earned in the amount of \$1,075,821.59.
 - ii) Probation Supervisor Amber Prewitt noted that all of the probation officers that recently attended POST have completed the training successfully.

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- iii) Assessor Adams discussed the difficulties in gaining access to the properties with the recent law changes. He explained that the use of Pictometry could be a proposed tool to utilize in lieu of physical inspection of properties. He noted that the cost of the Pictometry for Twin Falls County was noted to be approximately \$100,000.00 per year.

iv) IT Administrator Pigford stated that he will present a new password policy in the coming months.

- e) It was explained that it would be necessary to rezone about 30 acres which included a few other neighboring properties in order to connect to the Residential Agriculture zone. He stated that he did acquire the signatures of the other affected landowners of the properties to be rezoned in the process.

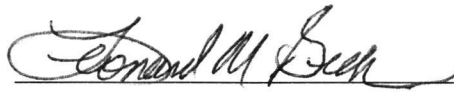
19) 10:59 AM Proposed County building discussion
